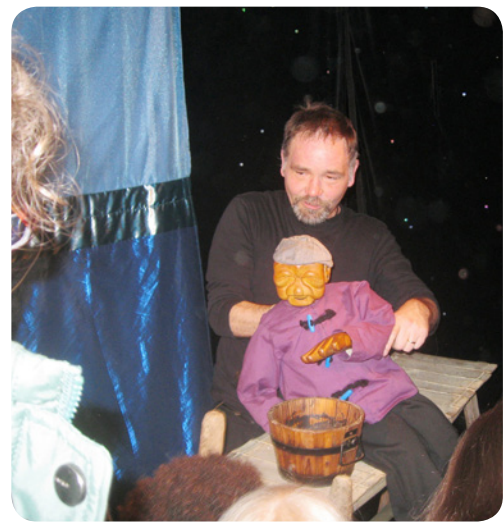
Oshima and the Big Sea at Half Moon Theatre, Saturday 18 January 2014:
